RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Use of mood-altering chemicals is prohibited while in treatment. This includes days and times that you are not actively receiving treatment.
- 2. Please inform staff of any mood-altering prescribed medications you are currently taking.
- 3. All clients will treat staff and peers with dignity and respect.
- 4. No verbal or physical violence or intimidation will be tolerated.
- 5. Physical violence will result in automatic discharge from the program.
- 6. No illicit drugs are allowed on the premises. Clients bringing illicit drugs or paraphernalia to IPSAC are subject to Administrative Discharge.
- 7. Regular attendance is of the utmost importance. If you are unable to attend, you are required to contact this office. Excused absences are at the discretion of staff.
- 8. 12 Step or faith-based meeting attendance is strongly encouraged to enhance your treatment and provide long-term social supports..
- 9. Group and individual sessions will begin on time and chronic tardiness will be considered a behavioral act of aggression.
- 10. No eating, smoking, or drinking will be allowed in group session or the group room.
- 11. No cell phones are allowed in group sessions.
- 12. Leisure clothing appropriate for treatment is acceptable with the exception of tank tops, sagging pants, short shorts, pajama pants, or other articles of clothing deemed inappropriate by staff.
- 13. All assignments must be completed prior to successful completion of the program.
- 14. Intentional damage to furniture or property may be grounds for administrative discharge.
- 15. It is your responsibility to assist in keeping the bathrooms clean.
- 16. No children are allowed in group treatment.

I have been given a copy of Iberville Parish Substance Abuse Center's (IPSAC) rules and regulations. I have had read and/or had the rules read and explained to me, and I understand these rules. I understand that IPSAC has the right to change or add rules as necessary for safe operation of the center, and that I will be informed of any changes or additions to the rules. I understand that I can have the rules explained to me as many times as necessary throughout my treatment. If I break any rule that puts myself, other clients, or staff in danger, I understand that I may be administratively discharged from the program.
