The Council on Aging Transportation Driver is responsible for providing safe and reliable transportation services to seniors, as well as assisting with meal delivery and facility maintenance tasks as needed. This role is required to work onsite, with frequent travel throughout the parish.

Responsibilities

Job duties include, but are not limited to:

- Packaging meals for delivery to homebound seniors according to established guidelines and protocols
- Delivering meals to seniors' homes in a timely and efficient manner, ensuring that all deliveries are completed on schedule
- Providing transportation services for seniors to and from the COA facility, medical appointments, grocery stores, and other essential destinations as needed
- Ensuring the safety and comfort of passengers during transportation, including assisting with boarding and disembarking as necessary
- Maintaining cleanliness and hygiene of the transportation vehicle, including regular cleaning and sanitization of high-touch surfaces
- Ensuring that the vehicle is in good working condition by performing routine maintenance checks and reporting any issues to the appropriate authorities
- Assisting with facility maintenance tasks, such as wiping down tables, cleaning bathrooms, and emptying trash bins, to ensure a clean and welcoming environment for seniors
- Handling paperwork related to meal delivery, transportation services, and client assessments, ensuring accurate record keeping and documentation
- Filling out assessments and reports as needed to track service utilization, client needs, and program outcomes

- Physical fitness and stamina to perform the duties of the job, including lifting and carrying meal packages and assisting passengers as needed

- Flexibility and adaptability to respond to changing needs and schedules, including occasional evening or weekend shifts
- Commitment to providing excellent customer service and support to seniors, promoting their independence and well-being

ESSENTIAL WORKER STATEMENT

Certain positions within this classification may require incumbents to be on-call 24/7. These roles are designated as essential, and individuals may be required to report to work during emergency situations as necessary.

CERTIFICATIONS/LICENSES/REGISTRATIONS

Positions within this classification may require a valid Louisiana driver's license or a valid Louisiana Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class A, B, or C with the necessary endorsements. If a license is required, it must be maintained for the duration of employment in this position.
