## **MILESTONES IN 2024**



A Vote for the Future - On November 5, 2024, Iberville voters overwhelmingly approved reinstating term limits in the Parish Home Rule Charter with 81% support.

**Listening to Our Community -** In May, we traveled across Iberville for community meetings, gathering your feedback to shape plans for the parish's progress.





**Enhancing Emergency Response -** We've partnered with the Iberville Parish Sheriff's Office to station a Deputy with our 911 dispatchers, speeding up emergency response times and ensuring quicker assistance for residents.

**Early Voting in North and East Iberville -** Exciting news for our North and East Iberville communities: early voting will soon be available right in your neighborhoods! We anticipate implementing this service in 2025.





**First Annual Employee Appreciation Day -** On September 14th, we held our First Annual Employee Family Fun Day, celebrating our amazing parish employees with the support of our generous sponsors.

**Investing in Our Team -** For the first time in 20 years, we conducted an Organization Assessment and Salary Review, ensuring competitive pay, fair incentives, and clear pathways for raises.





**Relocated the Parish President's Office -** The Parish President's office has returned to the Courthouse, reinforcing our commitment to accessibility and staying connected to the community.

## THE IBERVILLE PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council has the authority to pass ordinances to promote and protect public welfare, safety, health, peace, and manage parish affairs effectively. This authority is subject only to the Louisiana State Constitution and any state laws that specifically limit Parish Government powers. The Parish Council holds monthly meetings on the Third Tuesday of every month.



## **ORDINANCES PASSED IN 2024**

### **IPC Ordinance #001-24**

• Establishes rules for using athletic fields in the parish and sets rental fees for those who want to reserve them.

#### IPC Ordinance #002-24

 Adds term limits for parish council members and the parish president by amending the Home Rule Charter.

### **IPC Ordinance #003-24**

• Declares certain parish-owned properties as surplus and authorizes their sale through a public auction.

### IPC Ordinance #004-24

Approves the property tax rates for the year 2024.

### IPC Ordinance #005-24

 Allows the parish to sell surplus properties (declared in 2017) to nearby property owners, following earlier ordinance guidelines.

#### IPC Ordinance #006-24

 Sets minimum standards for outdoor storage facilities and contractor storage yards in the parish to ensure proper regulation.

### IPC Ordinance #007-24

• Updates rules for selling adjudicated properties (properties taken over due to unpaid taxes), allowing them to be sold to the highest bidder without a minimum bid.

### IPC Ordinance #008-24

• Introduces a property tax exemption for first responders who own and live in homes within the parish.

### IPC Ordinance #009-24

 Provides guidelines for placing recreational vehicles in unincorporated areas of the parish.

### IPC Ordinance #010-24

 Approves a reorganization of parish administrative departments, proposed by Parish President Chris Daigle, to streamline operations.

### IPC Ordinance #011-24

 Adopts the 2025 budget and updates the 2024 budget for both operating expenses and capital improvements in the parish.

### IPC Ordinance #012-24

• Merges voting precincts in accordance with state laws to simplify elections.

### **IPC Ordinance #013-24**

• Restricts the use of firearms in unincorporated areas to improve safety.

#### IPC Ordinance #014-24

• Replaces older ordinances related to removing and managing junked cars with a new, comprehensive set of rules.

**Iberville Parks & Recreation (IPRD)** is dedicated to maintaining our local parks and offering a wide variety of athletic programs for youth and adults year-round.

## **ANIMAL SHELTER & CONTROL**

The mission of the **Iberville Parish Animal Shelter & Control** is to foster a compassionate community by protecting and saving animals, providing exceptional care and treatment, advocating for their welfare, and strengthening the human-animal bond through education and outreach.

Our shelter is dedicated to reuniting lost pets with their owners, finding loving homes for homeless animals, and quarantining dogs and cats involved in bite incidents when necessary. We also investigate reports of animal cruelty and neglect to ensure the safety and well-being of all animals in Iberville Parish.

The shelter accepts stray animals found within the parish and, when space allows, owner-surrendered pets. Together, we can create a brighter future for animals and build a community rooted in kindness and care.

The **Iberville Parish Public Works Department** oversees drainage, roads, streets, and infrastructure improvements. It maintains parish properties, facilities, and equipment; handles road and drainage construction and repairs; and manages vehicle and equipment maintenance. The department also carries out additional tasks as assigned.

The department is always on call for water leaks or emergency damage and works tirelessly during emergencies like hurricanes, ensuring preparation and swift response to protect the community. No matter the weather—rain or shine, heat or cold—they remain dedicated to keeping lberville Parish running smoothly, responding to challenges in all conditions to ensure safety and reliability for residents.

Since many people no longer have home phones, it has become increasingly difficult to notify the public during emergencies. #### **IBERVILLE SALUTE TO VETERANS**




