The park maintenance worker is responsible for ensuring the cleanliness, safety, and attractiveness of parish parks. This role is required to work onsite in multiple locations throughout the parish.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Job duties include, but are not limited to:

- Mowing lawns, trimming edges, and maintaining landscaping to keep parks neat and well- kept
- Operating ride-on mowers, push mowers, and other landscaping equipment safely and efficiently
- Using weed eaters and trimmers to maintain edges and clear overgrown areas
- Clean park facilities, restrooms, picnic areas, and playgrounds regularly
- Emptying trash receptacles and ensuring proper disposal of waste
- Power washing sidewalks, pavilions, and other surfaces as needed
- Adjusting and maintaining sports fields, including marking lines, leveling surfaces, and ensuring proper drainage
- Coordinating with sports teams and event organizers to prepare fields for games and tournaments
- Supervise park activities and events, particularly during sporting events or large gatherings
- Ensuring compliance with park rules, safety regulations, and permit requirements
- Providing assistance and support to event organizers and participants as needed
- Inspecting and maintaining park maintenance equipment, including mowers, blowers, trimmers, and power tools
- Reporting any equipment malfunctions or safety issues to supervisors for prompt repair or replacement
- Adhering to safety protocols and guidelines while operating equipment and performing tasks

- Performing seasonal functions, maintenance, and winterizing of watering systems; including start-up and shut down of splash pads
- Performing proper use, storage, and disposal of insecticides, pesticides, weed killer, and other hazardous material

- Knowledge of landscaping equipment and techniques, including mowers, trimmers, and blowers
- Ability to lift and move heavy objects, work outdoors in various weather conditions, and perform physically demanding tasks

- Effective communication skills and the ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Availability to work flexible hours, including weekends and holidays as needed
- Ability to follow verbal and written instructions and maintain safety and risk
