RESPONSIBILITIES

Job duties include, but are not limited to:

- Safely operating trucks to transport materials, equipment, and personnel to designated locations
- Adhering to traffic laws and regulations while driving on public roads
- Maintaining cleanliness and performing routine maintenance checks on assigned trucks
- Utilizing specialized equipment such as bulldozers, loaders, and excavators to carry out designated tasks when needed
- Assisting in tree cutting and removal operations as directed
- Performing basic maintenance tasks on equipment and machinery to ensure optimal performance
- Adhering to all safety protocols and regulations while performing duties

QUALIFICATIONS

- A valid commercial driver's license (CDL) with a clean driving record
- Experience operating trucks and heavy equipment in a professional setting
- Proficiency in tree cutting techniques and safety procedures preferred
- Ability to understand and follow verbal and written instructions
