



The Iberville Parish Health Unit is operated by the Louisiana Department of Health and Human Services. Services include immunizations, family planning services, follow up care for tuberculosis, and the WIC Program (Women, Infants & Children) vouchers for milk and foods. Clinics are also offered at various times on sexually transmitted diseases.

Appointments are not required for immunizations. However, they are required for the other Health Unit services. Those requesting placement in the WIC Program should bring a picture ID and proof of income and residence to their appointment.

Services Provided:

- WIC (Supplemental food program for Women, Infants, and Children)
- Nutrition Counseling
- Immunizations
- Family Planning (Pap Smears, Birth Control)
- Sexually Transmitted Disease testing and treatment
- HIV Testing
- Tuberculosis testing
- Pregnancy tests
- Medicaid Services (LA Chip, Medicaid, LA Moms, etc.)
- Environmental Health Services (Inspections, Permits, Sanitation)
- Nurse Family Partnership Program (Nursing support for qualifying first time mothers)
- Blood Pressure and Glucose Screenings
- Vital Records (Death Certificates, Birth Certificate Applications)
